## Project Overview

The Lord Ellis Improved Forest Management (IFM) Project is located in northern Humboldt County, California, east of the community of Blue Lake. Developed under the California Air Resources Board (CARB) Compliance Offset Protocol – U.S. Forest Projects (Version: June 2015), this project represents one of Green Diamond’s smaller carbon initiatives, encompassing just under 2,000 acres of productive coastal forest.

Established in September 2016 by California Timberlands 2 LLC, the project was designed to promote long-term forest health and resilience through the adoption of improved forest management practices, the project aims to enhance stand structure, encourage the growth of large-diameter trees, and increase overall carbon storage capacity. Upon acquisition in 2023, Green Diamond assumed responsibility for the ongoing management and continued implementation of the project.



## Co-Benefits

**Habitat:** Beyond its role in carbon sequestration, the Lord Ellis Project contributes significantly to ecosystem restoration and habitat protection. The forested landscape provides vital habitat for several threatened and endangered species, including the Northern Spotted Owl, Coho and Chinook salmon, and steelhead trout.

**Ecological resilience:** By maintaining mature forest conditions and safeguarding riparian areas, the project supports biodiversity, improves water quality, and strengthens the ecological integrity of the surrounding watershed.
