

LOST TRAIL MONTANA CARBON PROJECTS

Connected habitats & Resilient forests

Located west of Glacier National Park and adjacent to the Lost Trail National Wildlife Refuge in NW Montana, the Lost Trail IFM projects were developed using ACR's IFM v2.0 methodology. Through changes in management, the projects are designed to reduce fire risk, enhance resilience, and sequester additional carbon while supporting the local timber economy. These sister projects produce high-quality carbon offset credits with meaningful co-benefits. With the additional protection of in-place conservation easements, the projects ensure public recreational access and continuity of wildlife habitat across this important ecological area. ACR1029 is owned by Southern Pine Plantations (SPP) and ACR753 is owned by Green Diamond Resource Company; both landowners are privately held and family-owned. The projects were developed and are managed by Green Diamond's experienced carbon team.
