

MARK E. REED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS NOW BEING ACCEPTED PRESS RELEASE

Deadline for receiving scholarship applications is Thursday, Feb. 29

(**SEATTLE, Wash.** – Feb. 2, 2024) Green Diamond Resource Company officials today announced that the [Mark E. Reed Scholarship](#) Washington board is now accepting scholarship applications from high school and undergraduate college students for the 2024-2025 school year. Eligible individuals will receive \$3,000 scholarships. [Applications](#) are due Feb. 29, 2024.

Eligibility includes employees, spouses or children of employees that work for Green Diamond Resource Company and Green Diamond Management Company, or students in our operating areas. Scholarships are available for the following areas:

- Northwest Timberlands
- Oregon Operations
- California Timberlands
- Montana Timberlands (Employees or spouses/children of employees only)
- Columbia Basin Management Area (Employees or spouses/children of employees only)
- Southeast Operations (Employees or spouses/children of employees only)

There are no restrictions for scholarship recipients as to race, age, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, veteran or marital status or sensory, mental or physical disability. While there are some variables in the selection process, merit is the principal determinant. Scholarships may be used for tuition, books or living expenses incurred while pursuing education beyond high school. During the academic year of the scholarship, award recipients must attend school full-time.

The scholarship program was established in 1947 in the memory of Mark E. Reed, who was Simpson Logging Company president from 1914 until his death in 1933.
